

F-TEC's RESPONSE TO COVID-19

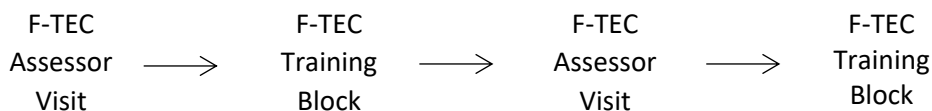

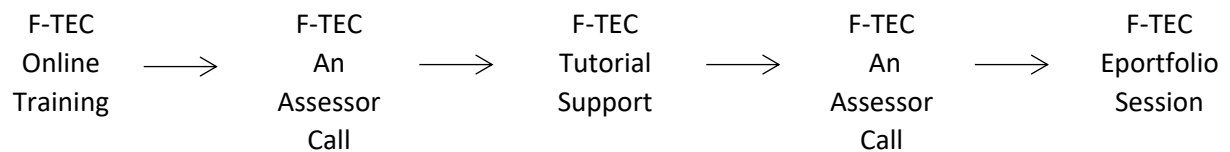
